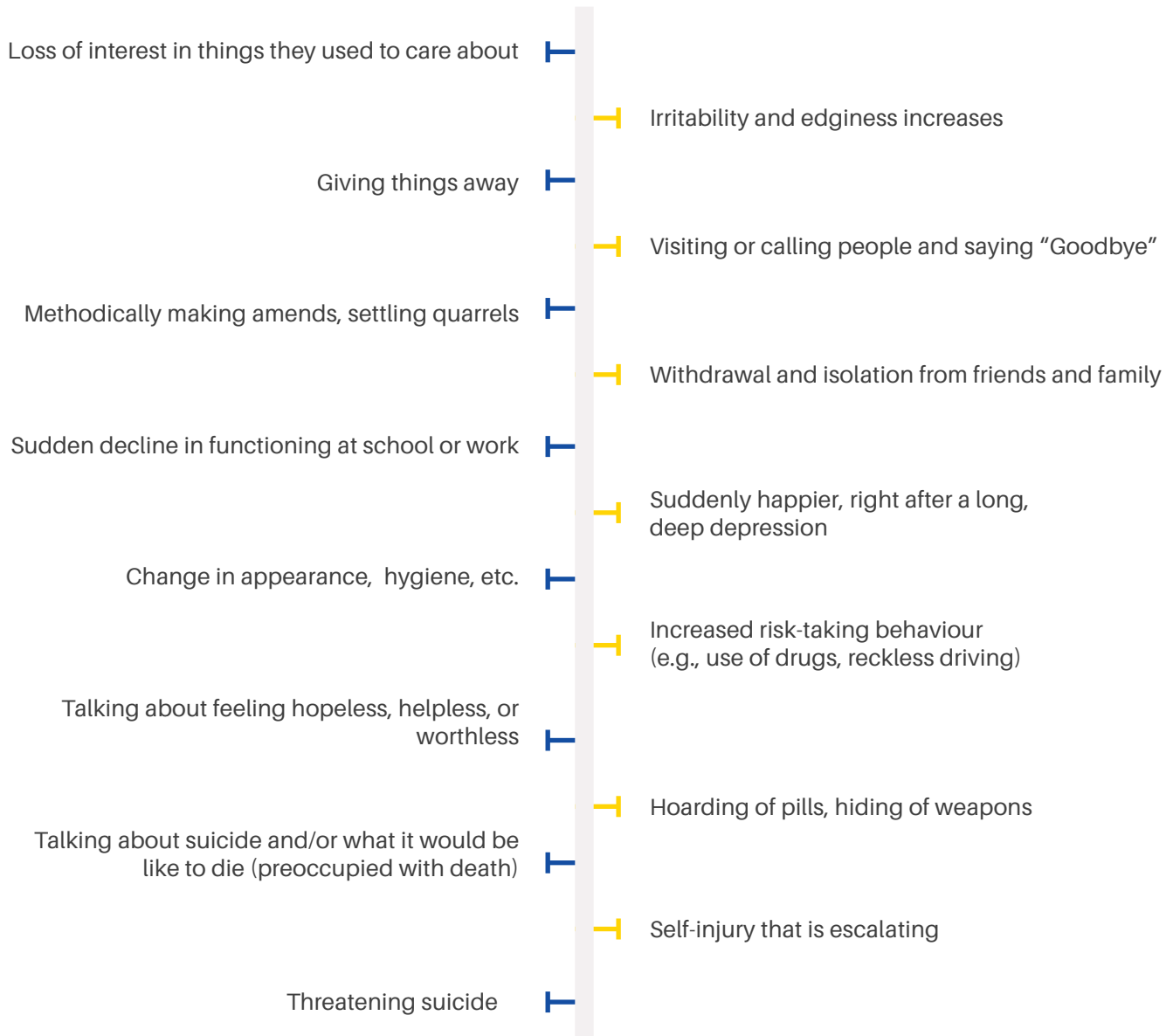


SUICIDE WARNING SIGNS

Direct statements:

Indirect statements:

- "My parents would be happier if I'd never been born."
